Creation Detectives–The Movie!

Just in time for [Creation Sabbath](#) 2021, [Creation Detectives–The Movie](#) is now available. Viewers will soon discover that Poirot, the Belgian hound dog, doesn't like heights. In fact, his main interest in life is bones, big bones. "That's what makes him my favorite character in [The Creation Detectives](#)," says Dr. Timothy Standish, "I like bones too, but perhaps for a different reason!" Poirot may have simple interests in life, but this balances out James' endless curiosity, Peter's unstoppable rich-kid energy and Diana's careful thinking, while occasionally upsetting even Pr. Max's calming influence. What could go wrong if they head down into the Grand Canyon to figure out how it formed, then report their findings at a scientific meeting?

[The Creation Detectives](#) is the brainchild of Manolo Quintanilla and Dr. Noemí Durán, director of the [Geoscience Research Institute](#) European Branch Office. "We noticed that children love comic book superheroes, and started a ministry dressing up as superheroes to visit sick children in hospitals," says Mr. Quintanilla, a hero himself as a former tank driver in the Spanish Army. "How better to lead children to the ultimate and real superhero, Jesus Christ? [The Creation Detectives](#) is another way in which we want to harness children's natural interest in comics to teach them about science, the creation and the Creator."

Dr. Duran adds that, "All the science that the curious and adventurous Creation Detectives heroes do—along with their antihero dog Poirot—is real science that has been published in the peer reviewed science literature by scientists who are Bible-believing Christians. In other words,

while the characters may be fictional, this is not science fiction, it is science fact and provides a great way of introducing children to real evidence that is consistent with the biblical record of history.”

Central to the challenge of making [*The Creation Detectives*](#) was the task of character development. Would the stories work at all if Diana wasn't thinking everything through, Peter wasn't causing mayhem while making it all happen and Poirot wasn't Belgian? Roberto Ballesteros and Pedro Aguerri of Naturaleza y Creación (Nature and Creation) in Zaragoza, Spain developed these compelling characters as part of their ministry's goal to spread the creation message, especially to children. [*The Creation Detectives*](#) are a team, and it took a team to bring them to life.

“I love the creativity exhibited in [*The Creation Detectives*](#),” says Dr. Standish. “We have worked with the [General Conference Children's Ministries Department](#) to produce printed copies, and digital versions can be downloaded from [grisda.org](#) and [creationsabbath.net](#), but we were looking for new ways of getting the information in this comic book out. That is when we discovered a whole genre of guided comic book dramatizations on YouTube. These are very popular and the [Voice of Prophecy](#) ministry was willing to team up with us to do the dramatization.”

Jean Boonstra at the [Voice of Prophecy](#) has extensive experience as creator and producer of the hit audio dramatization “[Discovery Mountain](#).” According to Mrs. Boonstra, who serves as Associate Speaker at [Voice of Prophecy](#), “We were excited to team up with the [Geoscience Research Institute](#) to create this audio-visual experience. We extended the expertise that we have developed in bringing stories to life through audio to this project. [*The Creation Detectives movie*](#) takes the existing format and adds another new and exciting dimension, and will reach even more children for Christ! And just so you know, my favorite Creation Detective is Diana, she is clearly the brains of the operation.”

Poirot may well agree, but he is fiercely loyal to Peter, his owner. He's happy to be with the group as they pursue their adventures, but it is Peter who smells far more interesting than the others. Now Poirot can't wait to get going on the next [Creation Detectives](#) expedition, this time to Peru, where there is a whale cemetery, and everyone knows, whales have huge bones!

[Creation Sabbath](#) is for everyone, especially children who need to learn about their Creator and Redeemer. Other Creation Sabbath resources for children can be found at the General Conference of Seventh-day Adventists Children's Ministries webpage.
